DPC/DGN/MB ORDINANCE NO. 180, OF JUNE 10, 2025

Approves the Maritime Authority Standards for the Prevention of Environmental Pollution caused by Vessels and Platforms – NORMAM-401/DPC.

The DIRECTOR OF PORTS AND COASTS, in the exercise of the powers conferred on him by Decree No. 12,002, of April 22, 2024; Ordinance MB/MD No. 37, of February 21, 2022; and in accordance with the provisions of article 4 of Law No. 9,537, of December 11, 1997, resolves:

Art. 1 To approve the Norms of the Maritime Authority for the Prevention of Environmental Pollution caused by Vessels and Platforms – NORMAM-401/DPC, which accompany it.

Article 2 It is hereby established that the application of penalties and sanctions resulting from infractions provided for in the new Chapter 4 of this normative act will begin on February 1, 2026.

Sole Paragraph: Until the date mentioned in the caput of this article, the Maritime Authority shall act in a guiding manner, promoting awareness and technical support to interested parties, with a view to adapting to the operational requirements established in said Chapter.

Art. 3 Ordinance DPC/DGN/MB no. 153, of January 15, 2025, published in the Federal Official Gazette (DOU) no. 12, Section 1, page 48, of January 17, 2025, is hereby revoked.

Art. 4 This Ordinance enters into force on the date of its signature.
